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# CHAPTER 1

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## API

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```
class aio_pubsub.interfaces.PubSub
    Main interface for implementation

    publish(channel: str, message: Any)
        Publish a message to channel

    subscribe(channel: str)
        Subscribe to one or many channels and return a Subscriber object

class aio_pubsub.interfaces.Subscriber
    Subscriber interface
```

A generic interface wrapping multiple backends to provide a consistent pubsub API.



# CHAPTER 2

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## Usage

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To use it, you need to implement your pubsub implementation from interfaces or use backends from `aio_pubsub.backends` package:

```
from aio_pubsub.backends.memory import MemoryPubSub
pubsub = MemoryPubSub()
# Create subscriber
subscriber = await pubsub.subscribe("a_chan")

# Push message
await pubsub.publish("a_chan", "hello world!")
await pubsub.publish("a_chan", "hello universe!")

# And listening channel
try:
    async for message in subscriber:
        print(message, flush=True)
except KeyboardInterrupt:
    print("Finish listening")
```



# CHAPTER 3
